Medications are available at \$0 cost share. Certain age restrictions apply.

Birth Control

ALL GENERIC PRESCRIPTION AND OVER THE COUNTER PRODUCTS INCLUDING:

medications taken by mouth, skin patch systems, injectables, intrauterine device (IUD), diaphragms, implants

Breast Cancer Prevention (adults age 35 years and over)

anastrazole	fulvestrant	SOLTAMOX
exemestane	raloxifene	tamoxifen

Cardiovascular Disease (adults age 40-75 years)

atorvastatin 10mg & 20mg	lovastatin 10mg, 20mg, & 40mg	rosuvastatin 5mg & 10mg
fluvastatin 20mg & 40mg	pravastatin 10mg, 20mg, 40mg,	simvastatin 5mg, 10mg, 20mg,
fluvastatin ER 80mg	& 80mg	& 40mg

Colonoscopy Preparation (adults age 45-75 years)

2 prescriptions per year only

bisacodyl
magnesium citrate

milk of magnesia polyethylene glycol

HIV Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP)

emtricitabine / tenofovir disoproxil fumarate (TDF) 200mg/300mg

Other

Aspirin 81mg for pre-eclampsia

ALL GENERIC OVER-THE-COUNTER PRODUCTS

Fluoride ≤ 1mg (persons 6 months through < 17 years)

ALL GENERIC PRESCRIPTION AND OVER-THE-COUNTER PRODUCTS

Folic Acid (patients age 0-50 years)

ALL GENERIC PRESCRIPTION AND OVER-THE-COUNTER PRODUCTS OF FOLIC ACID 0.4mg AND 0.8mg

Smoking Cessation (adults age 18 years and over)

bupropion sr	NICOTROL
nicotine gum/lozenge/patch	varenicline
